5. THE OBJECTS INCIDENTAL OF ANCILLARY TO THE ABOVE MAIN OBJECTS IS AS FOLLOWS:

1. To start and maintain Institutions like Institutes of health sciences, nursing schools, medical college, hotel management and catering technology Institutes, Fashion designing training centres, food processing, polytechnics, engineering colleges and other industrial training Institutes, teacher training institutes, hostels, life research centers etc. for the poor and downtrodden people.
2. To take up environmental educational programmes for children, students, youth, women and NGOs etc.
3. To establish and develop in the minds of the general public on the theme of universal peace.
4. To undertake and provide education, social, cultural and health awareness to the needy for the development of their standard of living.
5. To secure the cooperation and help of the government and the public at large.
6. To study, undertake research and implement projects, programmes, schemes and so on for schools and other student's social, cultural, educational, health, economic and ecological and environment development in India.
7. To adopt government and government aided schools and help in academic and non-academic aspects and conduct coaching programmes for various talent search and entrance exams.

8. To undertake education, legal, environmental, agricultural and family life awareness activities and to strengthen human resource development.
9. To seek the assistance of experts to improve medical care and education to the target people.
10. To make contribution for the relief of those affected by fire, pestilences, flood, tsunami, earthquake or other acts of nature
11. To establish, maintain, run, manage or assist in the establishment and management of hospitals, dispensaries, nursing homes, clinics whether it be allopathic, homoeopathic, Ayurveidc, Siddha or Unani and other traditional system of medicine.
12. To render and assist in providing medical aid to the sick, distitutes and suffering public, grant free medical aid and other clinical facilities conducive to the better health and well-being of the physically and mentally retarded people.
13. To undertake free health camps, medical screening, blood and eye donation programmes and environmental protection programmes.
14. To undertake development programmes in rural and urban areas such as sanitary works, construction of houses and water tanks, laying roads, rain water harvesting etc.
15. To undertake the propagation of literacy through adult and non formal education programmes and projects for the purpose of achieving 100% literacy.
16. To establish primary, nursery, high school, colleges and similar educational institutions technical instates (polytechnic ITI Engineering college) and blood banks, entrance examination coaching centres, reference rooms, study classes, hostels and vocational trainings for high school and higher secondary school students, recreations and welfare of the weaker sections of the people of different walks of life.
17. To carryout life education programmes which would promote and develop skills towards self employment and income generations.
18. To create and promote the non conventional energy creation schemes in order to maintain natural sources.
19. To carry out natural and organic agricultural programmes and research in production of natural organic manures and natural pesticides.
20. to takeup economic development programmes which will be sustainable for women in the downtrodden section of the society.
21. To maintain and establish training centres, craft centres, libraries, hostels, cottage industries, technical institutes, group homes for children's, students, aged and handicapped etc., health care communications, community development centre, counseling and legal aid centres.
22. To adopt children irrespective of sex, age, colour, caste, religion etc to undertake all arrangements for the betterment of the adopted children and it shall take all the necessary formalities from the government.

23. To borrow funds and moneys from any corporations state and central governments, nationalized or scheduled banks, financial institutions, etc either with or without security with or without interest and repay the loans property and regularly.
24. To establish and maintain and endowment funds for providing scholarships, loans, books and reading materials etc., to students from the weaker sections of the society.
25. To work for the upliftment of marginalized women, youth and working children and to free from social injustices, improve their economical statuses and obtain their basic human rights in the society.
26. To undertake nurseries and tree Plantation programmes.
27. To take up wasteland development programmes by programmes by promoting social forestry eco-clubs and environmental action groups.
28. To conduct awareness and training programmes for traditional art forms such as Kalari, Silambam and etc.
29. to conduct early intervention programmes, give rehabilitation, counseling and medical treatment free to cost for the disabled persons.
30. To take up health programmes such as AIDS awareness and prevention, HIV & STD awareness programmes and general health programme of both curative and preventive in rural and urban areas.
31. To work collaboration with similar social welfare organization in India and abroad to bring about national integration and international understanding and strive for social harmony and peace among the people of various races and religions.
32. to work for the elimination of child labour and to provide education and life development to children.
33. To run orphanages and institutes for physically handicapped and challenged children and also to carry out crèche programme.
34. To accept donations, gifts, presents, aids and grants in cash or kind, movable and immovable properties from the public state and/or central government and overseas funding agencies either as corpus or as income according to directions of the donors for the purpose of carrying the objects of the trust.
35. to enable to formulate and carryout common programmes and to support like minded organizations and individuals.
36. To prove awareness regarding child care, education, nutrition, environment, sanitation.
37. To undertake such other activities as may be necessary for be necessary for the attainment for the objects of the trust and for the removal of doubts it is hereby declared that all the objects of the trust shall be carried on with out any profit motive which are beneficial to the trustees either directly or indirectly.

- 38. To above objects are independent of each other and the trustees may from time to time apply funds of the trust in carrying out all or anyone of the objects of the trust.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE TRUST

Office : The Office of the Trust shall be situated now, "No.37, BUNDARRAJ NAGAR, SUBRMANYAPURAM, TRICHY-620 020" at Rental Building and in future at such other place or places in India as the Trustees may decide upon from time to time.

6. CONSITUTION:

- 1. **S. SYED SAMEER** shall be the Managing Trustee of the trust and he shall be entitled continue as such during his lifetime.
- 2. He has power to nominate any person in his place as Managing Trustee during his lifetime. That person shall hold office for lifetime.
- 3. And after that the Managing Trustee will be elected among the Board of Trustees and he shall be vested with all the power of function as Managing Trustee stated in this deed right from the day of his inception as Managing Trustee and hold office till his life time.
- 4. The other trustees will act as Trustees and hold office for their lifetime.
- 5. The Trustees will be entitled to reasonable honorarium for their service to the Trust.
- 6. The number of Trustees shall not exceed seven at any time.
- 7. In the case of death, resignation etc. of the Trustees, the Managing Trustee has the power to appoint any person in his place as Trustees.
- 8. The Managing Trustee has power to appoint any other person as Trustee, subject to the calling at any time.

7. THE MANAGING TRUSTEE SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING POWERS:

- 1. To draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, negotiate execute and encash cheques and bills of exchange and other negotiable instrument.
- 2. To institute, conduct, defend, compound, withdraw, compromise adjust, refer, to arbitrations or abandon any legal proceedings by the Trustees again the officers or employees, concerning the affairs of the trust and to sign and verify vakalat claims plaints statements, affidavit and other proceedings before all courts and government authorities both central and State.
- 3. To appoint from time and at any to suspend, dismiss, remove, or discharge any persons under his control including clerks, accountants and other employees with such power and duties and upon such terms, duration such terms, duration of office with honorarium.
- 4. To delegate to another trustees such works which has/have to be done by him/her.
- 5. To have control over the assets of the Trust.

8. MANAGEMENT:

1. Subject to the provisions herein, the Board Trustee shall be entitled to exercise all such power and all such acts and things as are necessary to carry the above-mentioned objects.
2. To Board of Trustee shall meet at least once a year for approving the statement of accounts.
3. To Board of Trustees shall act as a men or ordinary precedence with care and interest in discharging duties diligently and faithfully for the greatest advantage to achieve the objectives fo the Trust.
4. They should not in deterioration to the name and assets of the Trust. If any loss account because of the dishonest and carelessness of the trustees, then the should be personally liable of for such loss or losses.
5. If a trustee is proved by appropriate evidence as dishonest and of the activities are proved to be against the interest of the trust.
6. Then the managing Trustee may serve notice of termination on his after calling for his explanation.
7. The Board shall be entitled to make and prescribe from time to time the rules and byelaws and regulations for carrying the objectives of the trust and also modify or amend such byelaws and rules and regulations within the framework of the Trust.

9. TRUST FUND:

The trustees desire to hold the said amount of Rs.1,000/- and all other amounts and other properties whether movable or immovable including the investment anyway of shares, fixed deposits, Government securities bounds or debentures or in any other form that the trustees may receive and hold by way of acquisition, donation, gifts or otherwise howsoever (hereinafter referred to as the Trust Fund) upon the Trusts and for the object herein above mentioned. The funds of the will be utilized with in INDIA. The trust created shall be irrevocable. Finally trust fund Rs.1,000/- (Rupees Thousand Only) any other movable or immovable property not including.

10. TRUST MEMBERS:

1. The member of trustees shall be not less than seven and not more than exceeding.
2. All the trustees unless voluntarily resign or otherwise decide, shall continue to be the trustees during the term of their natural lives.
3. On any vacancy in the Board of Trustees by the death or by the resignation of a Trustee or any other cause, it shall be competent and lawful to appoint any person or legal heirs in the place of the person or persons who had ceased to be Trustees with the concurrence of the surviving trustees.
4. A person acting against the interest of the Trust shall cease to be Trustee, be being requested to resign by the majority members of the trust.

- 5. The trustees shall not be entitled to any remuneration but the trustees may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the trust or their duties relating thereto.

11. MEETING OF THE BOARD:

- 1. In addition to the annual meeting, the board may meet from time to time.
- 2. The Founder of the Trust shall convene the meeting and the Founder shall preside over the meetings.
- 3. The Board shall transact any business that may be specified in the agents or otherwise agreed to by the Board members.
- 4. The Board shall also appoint an auditor at the annual meeting for the subsequent year.
- 5. One half of the Board members of two members who ever is higher shall constitute the QUORUM.
- 6. All decision shall be carried out by the majority decision of the Board, but in the event by equality of votes, the founder presiding over the meeting shall have a casting vote.
- 7. Any resolution in writing signed by all the Trustees shall be binding on the Board as through it has been passed at a meeting of the Board or Trustees.
- 8. The meeting of the Board shall be convened after giving at least a weeks notice unless those who are entitled to received notice agree to accept a shorter notice.
- 9. The Founder may invite other interested in the work of trust to attend the meetings of the Board but they be entitled to vote there at.

12. BANK ACCOUNT:

The Founder shall be operating bank accounts individually or jointly with any one of the trustees.

13. INVESTMENT OF TRUST FUNDS:

The accounts of the Trust shall be maintained regularly and annually audited by a Chartered Accountant appointed by the Board of Trustees and the auditor statement of account shall be placed before the Board for its approval within six months from the close of the financial year.

14. APPOINTMENTS :

The Trustees shall be entitled to appoint from time to time staffs, professionals, Technical, Non-Technical, Trainers and etc., with such powers and duties and upon such terms as to duration of office remuneration or otherwise and at any time of suspended, dismiss, terminate, or discharge any or such of them as the board of Trustees shall think proper fit and necessary as employed and to make provisions for the benefits of the staff.

15. ACCOUNTS:

The Trustees shall keep proper accounts showing all receipts and disbursements made on accounts of the Trust here by constituted and a chartered Accounts shall duly audit the same once in every year as Trust appoints

The Receipts by the Managing Trustees or any other person duly authorized by the Trustees for the amount paid in respect of Trust fund or in respect of the Trust shall effectively discharge the persons paying the same there from assessing to the applications thereof.

16. PROPERTY:

The Trustees are empowered to acquire any movable or immovable properties for the benefit of trust and also in the name of the Trust. Also the Trustees are empowered to dispose any of the properties, which are best to sell than maintain and the trustees deed fit and proper.

Every property of the Trust, movables to be acquired in future shall be kept in the name of the Trust.

The Trust shall be entitled to levy charges, subscription and etc, and collect such fees or subscription and etc., as they may from time to time decide for the facilities to be provided at which of its projects and for the use of any occupation of the rooms, auditorium any other part of the buildings. There is no immovable property for the trust.

17. AMENDMENTS:

The Trust shall be entitled to frame rules and regulations for the conduct of its business, the administration of the trust, carrying out its objectives and facilities provided therein and to alter, amend or any such rules and regulations from time to time as they may deem proper. Such rules and regulations shall not be contravention of the provisions of the Indian Trust Act 1882 and Income Tax Act, 1961, in this respect.

18. BOARD MEETINGS:

The board shall conduct Board meetings once in three months to discuss the financial statement of the past months and all other subjects and also conduct an Annual General Body Meeting to discuss the Annual Report and Audited Financial Statements The Annual General Body Meeting should be conducted with in Three months from the end of the Financial year.

The Trustees or Trustee for the time being may reimburse themselves or himself or pay and discharge out of the Trust fund all expenses properly incurred in or about the execution of the Trust or powers under these presents.

Every resolution or decision of the Trustees unless unanimous shall be taken by majority of the Trustees present and voting and in the case of equality of vote, the Managing Trustee presiding or chairperson of the meeting shall have a case of vote. The Trustees may pass any resolution by circulation if it is unanimous.

19. BANK ACCOUNTS:

The Managing Trustee is fully empowered to open and operate an account or accounts with any one or more scheduled Banks, or Nationalized Banks or Co-operative Banks in the name of the Trust.

20. OTHERES:

It is hereby declared that no benefit accrued shall ensure either directly or indirectly at the Trustees.

The Trust fund shall be invested and Keep invested and deal with the fund in accordance with the provisions of Section 13 (1) (d) read with section 11 (5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961

For the purpose of carrying out objects of the Trust and for providing the facilities and undertaking the activities mentioned above, the Trustees shall be entitled to utilize the funds of the trust as well as its income in such a manner as they shall be their prudence and judicious.

To do business only if it is incidental to the attainment of the objectives of the trust and with in the parameters lay down in section 11(4A) of the income Tax Act 1961

This Trust shall be IRREVOCABLE for all time.

Whereas the Trust shall be in the event of dissolution or winding up to the funds shall not be paid or distributed among its Trustees but shall be given to such other Trust which is having similar aims and objects of this Trust as may be determined by the Trustee.

The amendments if any made to the Trust deed will not be extended to alter the basic Character/object of the Trust and no such amendment which may prove to be repugnant to be provision of section of section 2 (15), 11, 12,13 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961

If any amendment is to be made, the same is to be made with the prior approval of commissioner of Income Tax,

All the above objects shall be for the benefit of the General public without any distinction of caste, Class, colour, creed, sex or religion.

The Trust is not profit motivated.

No activity of the Trust will be carried out side of India

No portion of the Trust Funds will be utilized for payment to trustees by way of Salary, Profit, Interest, and Dividend etc.

21. LOANS:

The Trust shall be title to borrow loans form any state government of central Government, Nationalized or Scheduled banks or any financial institutions or non-Government financial institutions any abroad agencies/institutions and etc. and disburse of the same to the needy people and to collect the loan and repay it. The Trustees are empowered to create either simple mortgage or equitable mortgage of trust properties for the loans borrowed for the Trust.

22. DONATIONS:

The Trust may accepts any donations, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or in kind from any persons, institution or body of individuals or association of persons or Trust or Organization, with or without conditions from India or abroad. Incase of receipt of foreign donations, permission form the ministry of home Affairs will have to be obtained and code number will be obtained.

23. DISSOLUTION

Whereas the Trust shall be in the event dissolution or winding up the funds shall not be paid or distributed among its Trustees but shall be given to such other Trust which is having similar aims and objects of this Trust as may be determined by the Trustees.

The Trust has no other movable or immovable properties except the corpus fund Rs.1000/-
